What's the cost? \$375 for the Weekend. Limit 24 working Teams. A deposit of \$100 (non-refundable) is required to guarantee a spot by May 30th, 2015. The balance of \$275 is due by July 15th, 2015.

Can I audit? Yes! Audit fees are \$100/day. All levels of experience are welcome to audit.

Can I work a second dog? You may only work one dog at a time. However, if you want to substitute a second dog working at a similar or higher level to your first dog, please contact us so we can approve the substitution.

Are cancellations allowed? For cancellations more than 4 weeks prior to the Camp, *Before 7/20/15*, full refund is available. For cancellations less than 4 weeks prior to the workshop, no fees will be refunded unless we can fill your spot. Bitches in season and aggressive dogs are not allowed on the grounds. If you plan to attend with an intact bitch, you should plan ahead and arrange to have an alternate dog of similar skill level available to work. No refunds for bitches in season.

- Tiki represented the US at the World Agility Open in Belgium, winning Gamblers and taking 2nd in Biathlon Jumping

In 2013 Tiki enjoyed the podium twice at USDAA's Continental Championship of the America's! Yet again in July at the N. E Regional GP and Steeplechase Finals

In 2014 Monique and Tiki:

- Placed in the N.E.Regional GP & Biathlon classes
- Represented the USA at the IFCS World Championships in Holland
- Represented the USA at The European Open held in Hungary after earning a win-on spot on this AKC supported team.

And 2014 brought 20 month old Tush to competition. Now in AKC Excellent with an AD, Tush will be competing head to head with Tiki for a chance at USDAA Nationals and AKC Team Tryouts in 2015.

No matter your goal, your fitness level or your dog, Monique makes it fun and safe for all. She brings energy, challenging sessions and rewarding experiences for handlers and their dogs.

Monique's exposure to a large variety of training methods and handling styles allow her to adapt methods to best fit each dog and handler.
