Entry Method – Postmark Date

Opening Date: Tuesday, August 25, 2020

- Entries may not be postmarked before the postmark date above
- Entries received before the postmark date will be destroyed
- No entries can be accepted without a legible postmark date.
- All envelopes will be held for 7 days to allow for mail delivery. In the event that the trial limit is exceeded during the 7 days, entries will then be processed in postmark date order. A random draw will then be done from the entries for the postmark date when the limit will be reached.
- If entries received during the postmark 7 day period exceeds the trial's limit, a draw will be held: **9/4/20 Cheshire MA**
- Contact the trial secretary by **9/3/20** if you wish to attend the draw
- Overnight envelopes must have the recipient's signature waiver signed or the envelope may be refused or delayed

THERE WILL BE NO MEASURING OF DOGS AFTER JUDGE'S BRIEFING BEGINS– ALL DOGS WITHOUT A PERMANENT CARD MUST BE MEASURED BEFORE THE JUDGE'S BRIEFING TO SHOW THAT DAY – THERE WILL BE NO EXCEPTIONS

ENTRY ELIGIBILITY

Any trained, healthy dog 15 months or older may compete in a CPE agility trial. All purebred and mixed-breeds are equally eligible for entry. Bitches in season or any dogs who are blind, lame or aggressive towards people or other animals are not eligible to compete.

EFFECTIVE FOR ANY TRIAL HELD AFTER 01/01/03:

All dogs entered in a CPE agility trial MUST be registered with CPE prior to the host club's trial closing date.

OBSTACLES:

The following obstacles may be used. Obstacle specifications shall meet the current CPE obstacle requirements

Aframe – 9' sides, rubber granules, slats	Dog Walk – 12' planks, rubber granules, slats
Teeter – 12' plank, rubber granules, slatless	Weave poles – 24" poles - center to center
Jumps: Bar, Spread, Panel	Open Tunnels
	Pause Table – games only

PRIZES AND AWARDS

Ribbons will be awarded for 1st through 4th place for all classes. Teal rosettes will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dogs getting a new title will receive a title rosette.

We will be awarding a special prize to each team having a perfect weekend (all Q's). This is to recognize those teams who embody the CPE philosophy of fun and consistency. Good luck to all!

ENTRY FEES

Entries are \$14 per run. Package price, 1 dog, all runs both days - \$130

Day of Show, if the trial doesn't fill, \$18 per run. The trial secretary must be contacted before traveling to the trial site.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- ✓ The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- ✓ Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by action of the show committee. A refund of all but \$5 will be given for bitches in season. A letter from your veterinarian is required.
- ✓ It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) and / or children. Any exhibitor whose dog(s) and / or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the show committee, be asked to leave the show site. In that case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- ✓ No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- ✓ Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and legible information on the entry forms: illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the show.
- ✓ Obstacles shall meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials.
- ✓ There is a returned check fee of \$25.

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE

FROM THE NORTH: Take 87 (Northway) south to exit 15. Turn right at the top of the exit ramp and head toward Saratoga Springs on Rt. 50 South. Follow Rt. 50 until it intersects with Broadway. Turn left at stop light, continue on Rt. 50/Broadway. At the third stoplight, turn right onto Church St. (Rt. 9N). The HUGE, WHITE Adirondack Trust building is on one corner and City Hall on the opposite corner. Take Church St. (9N) out of Saratoga Springs. You will go past the Saratoga Hospital on the right, past a medical complex. Continue for approximately 5 miles. You will eventually come to the little village of Greenfield Center. At the stoplight, turn left onto South Greenfield Rd. Go up a little hill, down the hill and then on the right you'll see yellow and black arrow signs, the driveway for Jazz is just past those signs. Drive up the paved driveway, past a large white house.

FROM THE SOUTH: Take 87 (Northway) north to exit 15. Turn left at the top of the exit ramp and head toward Saratoga Springs on Rt. 50 South. Follow Rt. 50 until it intersects with Broadway. Turn left at stop light, continue on Rt. 50/Broadway. At the third stoplight, turn right onto Church St. (Rt. 9N). The HUGE, WHITE Adirondack Trust building is on one corner and City Hall on the opposite corner. Take Church St. (9N) out of Saratoga Springs. You will go past the Saratoga Hospital on the right, past a medical complex. Continue for approximately 5 miles. You will eventually come to the little village of Greenfield Center. FROM THE EAST: Take Rt. 7 to 87 north (Northway) or take Interstate 90 to 87 north (Northway). Go north to exit 15. Turn left at the top of the exit ramp and head toward Saratoga Springs on Rt. 50 south. Follow Rt. 50 until it intersects with Broadway. Turn left at stop light, continue on Rt. 50/Broadway. At the third stoplight, turn right onto Church St. (Rt. 9N). The HUGE, WHITE Adirondack Trust building is on one corner and City Hall on the opposite corner. Take Church St. (9N) out of Saratoga Springs. You will go past the Saratoga Hospital on the right, past a medical complex. Continue for approximately 5 miles. You will eventually come to the little village of Greenfield Center. At the stoplight, turn left onto South Greenfield Rd. Go up a little hill, down the hill and then on the right you'll see yellow and black arrow signs, the driveway for Jazz is just past those signs. FROM SCHENECTADY: Take Rt. 50 North to Saratoga Springs. Continue through the City of Saratoga Springs to the intersection with Rt. 9N (Church St.) turn left onto Church St. and head west out of Saratoga Springs. The HUGE, WHITE Adirondack Trust building is on one corner and City Hall on the opposite corner. Take Church St. (9N) out of Saratoga Springs. You will go past the Saratoga Hospital on the right, past a medical complex. Continue for approximately 5 miles. You will eventually come to the little village of Greenfield Center. At the stoplight, turn left onto South Greenfield Rd. Go up a little hill, down the hill and then on the right you'll see yellow and black arrow signs, the driveway for Jazz is just past those signs. Drive up the paved driveway, past a large white house.

Please read the confirmation letter for important information on parking. There is no camping at this site but there are several campgrounds close by. The trial will be run using current CPE and NYS COVID-19 guidelines. There will be no worker food or a food vender at this trial.

Jump Heights – no dog will jump lower than 4”

P-Card = Permanent Card: the lowest allowable Regular height a dog may jump in CPE.

GENERAL CPE RULES FOR ENTRIES/SHOW SITE:

- Dogs must be at least 15 months or older the first day of the trial
- Blind (both eyes), lame, in season or aggressive dogs may not enter the show. The Club may choose to exclude any of the above from the site.
- Dogs must be registered with CPE prior to the closing date of the trial, or by the trial date for Day Of Show entries. Registration forms are on the Forms page: www.k9cpe.com. Forms MUST be mailed to CPE and are processed 2-3 times per week. CPE ID numbers are emailed to legible email addresses. Registrations can only be processed from mailed forms.
- Dogs must be able to be measured at their first show. If a dog cannot be measured, the dog cannot run and no refund will be issued. Dogs within ½” of a jump height require at least one more measurement. When dogs reach their second birthday, a measurement is required. All dogs must be measured at their first trial regardless of jump height.
- Only CPE Judges can measure dogs.
- Electronic shock collars are not allowed at ANY CPE trial – training or bark.
- Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A warm-up jump shall be provided for all entered dogs. No relieving of dogs in the warm-up area.

Dogs in the ring, leashes, exiting the ring

- Dogs shall run without anything attached to its body. This is for the safety of the dog. This includes no: collars, stitches, wraps or any other item. The only exception is a small barrette or rubber band to keep hair out of a dog’s eyes.
- Leashes may not have anything (other than name/license tags) attached to them when used in the ring.

- Dogs may enter the ring on a collar, quick release harness or head halti/leader. If prong collars are allowed per the show site, they may *not* be used to take a dog into the ring.
- Handlers may not carry their leash with them on the course – if done so, an NT will result. Exception: Handicapped handlers that have a mobility problem in picking up the leash at the finish may put their leash in their pocket – the leash must be out of sight.
- Dogs must be under the handler’s control when leaving the ring or the judge may enter the run as No Time - NT.

Training a dog in the ring during a run

We, AgileDogs, will offer Declared training in the ring. The handler has the option if they want to use a toy or training aid at any time during their run, the handler must approach the Judge during Walkthrough or previously in that trial day for the Judge to approve the toy or training aid for use on the course.

- Handler must alert the Judge upon entry to the ring that the dog will be TIR. Handler is then allowed to have a reasonably sized silent toy/aid with them for use once their run has started (this toy must be approved by the Judge of record PRIOR to the start of the class to determine its eligibility, absolutely no food/scents/audible devices). The toy is NOT allowed to be used in either gate chute or prior to the previous dog leaving the ring.

See the online rulebook or current member letter for additional rules.

The following items are considered training in the ring (see Fix and Go):

- Violating the 4 paw safety rule (directing the dog back onto the contact)
- Start line stay – leaving the dog and going back again to reposition the dog after the handler passes the plane of the first obstacle (before the handler leaves the dog, repositioning or repeated commands can be a delay of start)
- Putting the dog back on the table in the point games

While running on course

- The handler will direct the dog through the course without a collar or lead.
- Food, toys, training devices (includes fanny packs and leash attachments) are not allowed within 10’ feet of the ring. Clickers, training whistles and squeaky toys are not to be used within distraction distance of the ring.
- The handler may not carry anything that could aid the dog in its performance. Exclusion: Handicapped/Differently Abled Handlers using a cane, scooter, wheelchair, etc., to enable their progression around the course.

The handler may use any verbal or visual commands to direct the dog through the course. The Judge may assess a 5 fault penalty to elimination for any command that is not given in a sportsmanlike manner. Faults can be, but are not limited to: foul or abusive language, display of anger, extreme frustration or excessive harshness. If the fault is severe enough, the Judge has the right to excuse the exhibitor from the ring and / or the remainder of the trial. If excused from the trial, a report would be filed with CPE. See Faults, Eliminations and Excusals in the rulebook.
