Hello, Exhibitors!

Thank you for entering the September 9 & 10 2017 CPE Trial hosted by Agility Dogs of Schenectady. This is your final entry confirmation. With your help things will run smoothly; if everyone helps out the day will go faster. We hope you will have fun this weekend!

Please note: Please check your individual run information carefully, you should have received it already. You have until 6 pm on Tuesday, Sept 5th to email Trisha Stall Trisha@agiledogs.net with your move ups and/or corrections. Any changes made after that date will incur a \$10 charge per change, regardless of whose error it was.

Stockade Site details:

1. It is absolutely required that you pick up after your dog. Failure to do so will result in being excused from the trial.
2. Bring your own chairs and shade; there will be a main shade tent, but it is only for dogs and people about to go into the ring for their runs.
3. Remember that ticks abound in this area, so be sure to check your dogs for ticks, especially if you walk them in the woods or edges of clearings.
4. Cars must be parked in designated areas, and may not be driven around the rings after the general briefing each day. PLEASE 5 MPH MAX ON THE TRIAL SITE! This includes the driveway.

OVERNIGHT / RV PARKING:

If you have signed up to camp overnight at Stockade, make sure you contact Pat Snyder, stockadeagility@nycap.rr.com to let her know the size of your RV and if you'll be using a generator or not. If you're staying in a tent or vehicle and indicated that on your form and have paid in full, you're all set and do not need to contact her. When you arrive, see Pat, who will escort you to your parking spot.

Trial Format:

Two 100' x 100' rings will be used, and will be fully enclosed with entry/exit gates. Electronic timing will be used.

Check-in, Measuring, and Starting Times:

Friday: There will be no check in or measuring on Friday

Saturday: Check-in and measuring from 7:30 – 8:00 am, General / Judges' briefing 8:00, 1st dog on the line immediately after walkthroughs

Sunday: Check-in and measuring from 7:30 – 7:45 am General / Judges' briefing 7:45, 1st dog on the line immediately after walkthroughs

VOLUNTEERS:

Please sign up to work whatever classes you can. Thanks to all who volunteered!

All volunteers will get our undying gratitude (because you know we can't host trials without your help!), and will also get the following perks:

- \$4 in lunch tickets good at our food vendor
- Two raffle tickets for each class worked

Please do not worry about conflicts between classes you're working and classes you're running in. All workers will be accommodated. You can move your dog within a class to make sure you have time to concentrate on having a successful run with your 4-footed partner!

DIRECTIONS TO STOCKADE POLO CLUB – 505 Sacandaga Road (Route 147), Glenville, NY.

Our driveway is directly across from Spring Road. From Route 29 (points north): Turn on Route 147 heading south. Pass through Galway, cross Route 67 and continue on Route 147 toward Scotia. Show is approximately 9 miles from Route 67, on the right. From Route 67: Take Route 67 west from Ballston Spa / east from Amsterdam, to Route 147 (traffic light, Stewart's, big white church at intersection). Turn south on Route 147 and proceed 9 miles. Grounds are less than one mile (south) past Stewart's on route 147. Look for the blinking traffic light, Beukendaal Firehouse on the right. The Stockade driveway is just before the Beukendaal Firehouse on the right. From I-90/Route 890- (points east): Take Route 890 west (from Thruway exit 25 or other access) toward Rotterdam. Continue past Schenectady, Campbell and Rice Roads. Route 890 will take you across the Mohawk River to Route 5. Cross Route 5 (do not turn). 890 becomes Vley Road. Continue on Vley Road to Route 147 access on the right, immediately after an underpass. Turn right (north) onto Route 147, over bridge (passing back over Vley Road), and look for the Beukendaal Firehouse immediately after the bridge on your left. The driveway to Stockade is just past the Beukendaal Firehouse on the left. From I-90/Route 890 (points west): Take Route 890 west (from Thruway exit 26 keep left after toll booths). Route 890 will take you across the Mohawk River to Route 5. Cross Route 5 (do not turn). 890 becomes Vley Road. Continue on Vley Road to Route 147 access on the right, immediately after an underpass. Turn right (north) onto Route 147, over bridge (passing back over Vley Road), and look for the Beukendaal Firehouse immediately after the bridge on your left. The driveway to Stockade is just past the Beukendaal Firehouse on the left.
